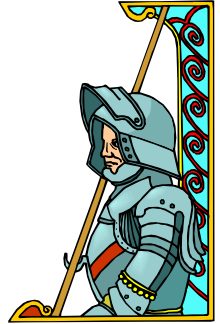

POPE JOHN PAUL II ASSEMBLY **Fourth Degree News from the Navigator**



In June nominations for the Inside Sentinel were re-opened, as S.K. Frank Galley Jr. is unable due to other commitments to perform the duties of the position. The Inside Sentinel for 2012-13 is S.K. George Lee. Other actions taken during this meeting were approvals of \$100 for the Archdiocese for the Military, \$50 for the CYO Track & Field Championships, an additional \$100 for the Roman Missals given to the priests of the Archdiocese of Detroit, approval of \$200 for the Installation of Officers to be held on July 18th at Rob't Jones in Lincoln Park at 7 p.m. A resolution was brought forward and needs to be published prior to our vote at the August meeting.

RESOLUTION: *Whereas the Chalice Fund upon reaching an amount of \$2,000 that all additional funds from dues be placed in the Color Corps Fund for (1) one year and said resolution be taken up after (1) one year for re-evaluation.*

The purpose for bringing this resolution forward is due to the cost of the regalia for an individual. It is a detriment for some members who may be interested in becoming part of the Color Guard. The assembly will be able to purchase the regalia and then loan it out to those interested and be returned to the assembly when the S.K. is no longer interested or able to perform the duties. Additionally, SK Joe Kimmel was honored as "SK of the Year"

The assembly was able to present the chalice of deceased member S.K. Ed Wesolowicz to Fr. Steve Mateja on May 27th at Fr. Steve's Thanksgiving Mass. We had (15) Color Corps present with (7) members from Pope John Paul II Assembly #2942. There were several other members and spouses representing the assembly and All Saints Council, as well.

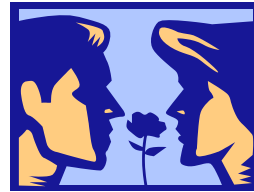
